- ❖ **Lemons** are very limited and prices remain high this week. CA crops are done and Chilean product is delayed due to weather issues. 140 lemons are tight. We suggest to substitute for 165 when possible. Due to the shortage, we are mostly stocking *standard* product. Expect quality issues.
- ❖ **Bosc Pears** are gapping and will not be available for another three to four weeks. If possible, consider replacing them for Asian pears. We are also seeing the last of the **D’Anjou pears**. Quality issues may arise. Local Bartlett are expecting to start next week. In the meantime, we suggest to replace them for **Comice** pears.
- ❖ **Garnet Yams** are gapping. Medium size is very limited and prices are elevated. Jumbos still available.

Greens: Spring mix, spinach, arugula, and baby kale all steady.

Lettuce: Iceberg and Romaine prices are slightly up this week.

Melon: Most Melons are from California crops.

Onions: Red onions prices are leveling down.

Squash: Zucchini and Yellow squash prices are steady. Recommended good buy this week.

Stonefruit: Peaches and nectarines from California's Central Valley and Delta are available. Prices are steady.
