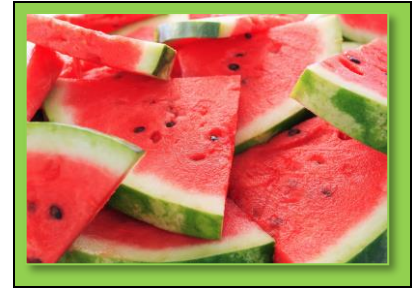

- ❖ **Lemons** continue to be very limited and prices remain high. CA crops are done and Chilean product is delayed. 140 lemons are tight. We suggest to substitute for 165 when possible. Due to the shortage, we are mostly stocking *standard* product. Expect quality issues.
- ❖ **Avocados** prices are high this week on all sizes as California crops are finishing and we transition into Mexican product.
- ❖ **Cilantro & Basil** prices remain this week. Warm weather during the day and cold weather at night is damaging local crops reducing its availability. Expect some quality issues. Market remains tight.

Bell Peppers: Prices are steady on all colors.

Bananas: Prices are steady.

Berries: Strawberries – prices are steady. Quality issues may arise due to warmer weather affecting the product. Recommended good buy this week.

Blueberries – Prices are steady. Recommended good buy. Raspberries and Blackberries – Prices are steady.

Brussel Sprouts: We are seeing new California product. Prices are leveling down.

Carrots: Prices are leveling down.

Cauliflower: Prices are slightly up this week.

Citrus: Lemons- Very limited and prices remain high. Strong market. Limes – 200 ct. prices are slightly up. 110 ct. prices are steady.

Corn: California yellow and white corn available from Brentwood.

Cucumber: Prices are steady.

Eggs: Prices have dropped this week.

Eggplant: Prices are slightly up this week.

Greens: Spring mix, spinach, arugula, and baby kale prices are steady. Expect some quality issues caused by weather extremes (warm weather during the day and cold weather at night)

Lettuce: Iceberg and Romaine prices are steady.

Melon: Most Melons are from California crops. Prices are steady.

Onions: All #1 product. Prices are slightly up.

Pears: Bosc s and D'Anjou pears are done. Local Bartlett now available.

Squash: Zucchini and Yellow squash prices are steady. Recommended good buy this week. Happy Boy mixed toybox also available. Call your sales rep for more info.

Stonefruit: Peaches and nectarines from California's Central Valley and Delta are available. Prices are steady.

Tomatoes: 4x5 and 5x5 prices are slightly up. Happy Boy Farms Heirloom Tomatoes also available. Looking and tasting amazing!
