**Asparagus:** Prices remain high this week due to weather issues in the growing regions of Mexico. Expect mixed sizing and quality issues.

**Avocados:** Prices are still adjusting down. Limited California fruit on the market, most fruit coming from Mexico.

**Brussel Sprouts:** Local Brussel Sprouts from Giusti Farms in Half Moon Bay. Recommended good buy this week.

**Bananas:** Prices are steady.

**Berries:** Strawberries – Prices are up. Expect some quality issues due to weather extremes (warm days and cold nights).

**Carrots:** Prices are steady. Organic Nantes now available, contact your sales representative.

**Cauliflower:** Prices steady.

**Citrus:** Lemons- Strong market. Prices are starting to adjust down. Product now coming from Mexico. Limes – Prices are adjusting downward.

**Corn:** Brentwood corn is gapping. Prices are high this week.

**Figs:** Black Mission and Brown Turkey available for another 3 or 4 weeks if the warm weather continues.

**Greens:** Spring mix, spinach, arugula, and baby kale prices are steady. Expect some quality issues in Spinach caused by weather extremes.

**Lettuce:** Prices are steady.

**Mango:** California grown Keitt Mangoes are here! Don' be fooled by their green skin. Tender and oh so sweet.

**Melon:** Most Melons are from California crops. Season is coming to an end. Recommended good buy.

**Onions:** Prices are steady.

**Peppers:** Green Bells prices are up and Red Bells are down this week. Jimmy Nardello's available from Happy Boy for a limited time.

**Squash:** Zucchini and Yellow squash prices are slightly up this week. Happy Boy mixed toybox also available. Call your sales rep for more info.

**Stonefruit:** We are nearing the end of stone fruit season and product is a hit or miss. We recommend to replace them with apples, pears and pomegranates instead.

**Tomatoes:** Roma tomatoes prices are high this week. For a cost-effective option we suggest using 5x5. Happy Boy Heirloom still available for another 3 or 4 weeks if the weather holds. Green tomatoes also available. Call your Sales Representative for more information on this item.
