- ❖ **Berries** prices are spiking this week, especially on blueberries. Expect some quality issues due to weather extremes (warm days and cold nights).
- ❖ **Green Onion** prices continue to be high this week. Market is extreme. Supplies are limited due to the intense heat affecting the Baja desert and severe rain from Hurricane Rosa impacting the Southwest. Expect shortages, quality issues and high prices.
- ❖ **Lettuce** – Greenleaf, Iceberg, Romaine, Little Gem- prices remain high this week as we transition from Salinas to California desert fields. Expect some quality issues, such as burnt tips, due to cold weather at night.
- ❖ **California Valencia & juicing oranges** prices remain high this week. Demand continues to be strong and market is tight. We are expecting this situation to continue for the next couple of weeks.
- ❖ **Cucumbers** continue to be limited and prices remain high. Expect some quality issues.
